

# Privacy Statement

## VDH

This is the privacy statement of VDH, having its registered office in Ritthem and entered in the Commercial Register of the Chamber of Commerce under number 40410257, hereinafter referred to as the “Association”.

You may knowingly or unknowingly share personal data with us. We consider the careful handling of your personal data to be important. Accordingly, this statement explains how we process your personal data and the rights you have in that regard. ## Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is sent with the pages of a website and stored by the browser on your computer, tablet or mobile phone. We use cookies to provide a better service when you visit our websites and to make those websites easier to use. ## Disclosure of Personal Data to Third Parties

Without your consent, the Association will disclose your personal data to third parties only where this is necessary for the performance of the agreement between you and the Association, unless the Association is under a legal obligation to disclose your personal data to such third parties. The table at the beginning of this privacy statement provides an overview of the situations in which personal data are disclosed to third parties.

## Access, Rectification and Erasure of Personal Data

You have the right to request access from the Association to your personal data (unless, under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Association is not required to provide such access), and to request that your personal data be supplemented, erased or restricted. You must identify yourself when making such a request. If you wish your data to be erased, the Association will notify all other organisations that have received the relevant data from the Association of that erasure.

## **Security of Personal Data**

The Association takes appropriate measures to protect your personal data against loss, unauthorised access, disclosure and unlawful processing. For example, we ensure that only those persons who need access to your data are able to access it, that access to personal data is restricted, and that our security measures are reviewed regularly.

## **Minors**

If, as a minor, you wish to register, you must provide the explicit consent of your parent or guardian.

## **Links to Other Websites**

The website may contain links to other websites. This privacy statement applies solely to the Association's websites. Other websites may have their own privacy policies. The Association therefore recommends that, before using any other website, you consult that website's privacy statement.

## **Event Entries**

Pursuant to the KR (Article IV.17 KR), a dog may only be entered for an exhibition if the prescribed document has been completed in full. By registering, the exhibitor accepts our jurisdiction. Article IV.26 KR lists the data that must in any event be included in a catalogue. These include the names of the members of the organising board and any delegate of the Raad van Beheer, the names of the dogs together with their Dutch or foreign registration marks, their titles, dates of birth, the name of the breeder, the names of the parent dogs, the name of the owner, the address details of the exhibitors and the names of the judges. The publication of digital results on our website also falls within this scope; this follows from the acceptance of jurisdiction and performance by VDH. The lawful basis for including these data is a contract.

## **Photographs and Other Images**

If a person, whether a minor or an adult, is recognisable in an image, that photograph may not be published without permission. By participating in one of our events, you consent to publication.

## **Annual Submission of Member Lists by Circle Groups to VDH**

The articles of association provide that an association must submit a member list annually. The lawful basis for this is the performance of a contract in combination with a legitimate interest.

## **Processing Results of Screening Examinations**

A dog does not fall within the scope of protection of the GDPR.

## **Publication of Mating and Litter Information on the Website or in the Club Magazine**

The breeder and the association agree that the breeder will keep the breed association informed of matings and litters and that this information may be published. The breeder provides these data in order to fulfil his or her obligation to the breed association. Publication constitutes performance of a contract.

## **Updates to this Privacy Statement**

The Association amends its privacy policy from time to time in order to keep it up to date. The most recent version of this privacy statement will always be published on the websites. The Association therefore recommends that you consult this privacy statement regularly. In the event of important changes, the Association will do everything reasonably possible to inform you by email and through the websites.
